



Reporting accidents on a Banyule BUG ride

The B-BUG Committee has agreed that, whenever an incident or accident occurs on a scheduled B-BUG ride*, an *Accident Report Form* should be completed by the Ride Leader, or another rider who was at the accident, as soon as possible after the event. The main reasons for this decision:

- We want to build a comprehensive record of **all** accidents — major and minor — that occur on our rides. The information should help improve safety on BUG outings and analyse the value of our insurance policies.
- Unless paramedics or police are involved, cycling accidents are largely unreported. Collating accurate information will provide invaluable data when advocating on behalf of cyclists and, particularly, for the many social riders who belong to clubs such as Banyule BUG.

The term “accident” should be interpreted broadly, ranging from major falls, crashes and collisions which might require an ambulance and paramedic assistance, to minor grazes and cuts that can be fixed with a plaster or two.

Equally important is the involvement of third parties — knocking over a pedestrian, scraping a vehicle; damaging a bike, etc. Some incidents may have implications for our insurance; most will not.
